The continuation of the **TRIBAL X2** will help you fine tune the fundamentals, such as posture, snaky arms and shimmies. Fast-paced and fun, the drills covered will compliment the edgy combos taught at the end of class to the rakin music. Jenny strives to maintain an all-encompassing sisterhood with positive energy in her classes.

Jenny began her dance training during childhood, but branched out beyond traditional ballet and jazz classes after being introduced to oriental dance by a Persian friend's mother at age 8. Since then, she has been fascinated by the various forms of dance that can be found in different parts of the world. Motivated by her travels, she attended tango classes in Buenos Aires and, during a semester abroad in Barcelona, took R&B classes at BCN Studios and tribal fusion in Munique Neith's studio. Jenny was a featured dancer in the award-winning Houston band Mango Punch!'s music video "*Que se lleve el viento mi dolor.*" Her belly dance education includes workshops from Bozenka, Zoe Jakes, Jill Parker and Helena Vlajos; Jenny has also taken tribal fusion classes from Nari and Silvia Salamanca. In May of 2008, Silvia asked her to become a member of Shunyata Belly dance. She is currently completing her undergraduate thesis based on Orientalism and the morphology of oriental dance.
